Recap of Last Week's Supreme Webinar

Please encourage all of your Assemblies to sign up and participate in all of the upcoming webinars. These webinars will give every Assembly the information needed to stay in touch with members, hold virtual meetings, vote in upcoming elections, and participate in virtual Exemplifications to name a few. This is a work in progress for all of us, so let's be flexible in how we move forward. I want each of you to communicate this week with every Assembly in your District and copy me on those communications.

I will go through a recap of last week's Supreme webinar meeting.

- 1. There will not be any State Conventions held in person. Supreme is working to finalize virtual conventions, as are many individual states. Please call your State Deputy to find out what is the date of his State's upcoming virtual convention and DO NOT plan anything on that date other than attending his convention online. Plan your Biennial meeting date around the State Deputy's schedule; do not interfere with any plans he has. It is vital that you communicate with your State Deputy during these times and work in conjunction with him.
- 2. An exciting new program from Supreme called, "Leave no neighbor behind."

I want every Assembly active in this program and to partner with the Councils assigned to each Assembly. The five points of this program are:

- * Reach out to Members.
- * Provide for your Parish.
- * Care for your Community.
- * Promote blood donations.
- * Support local food banks.
- 3. ETools on Member Management: The amount of information your FN and Comptroller can pull from member management is huge. The outline listed below under the tools sections shows how Assemblies and Councils can put an email and call list together in the matter of a few clicks. Most Assemblies and Councils use this already. I know my Assembly does. However, concentrate on the ones who don't, find a young member in your district that can help the older FN's and comptroller navigate the information to the Assemblies' benefit.

- 4. ETools for Holding Meetings: The link below also has several programs that are available that will allow Assemblies to hold virtual meetings, hold elections, participate in virtual Exemplifications. Zoom, Skype, Free Conference Call, and Flocknote are just some of the great programs available. I currently use Zoom, Free Conference Call, and Skype. I would ask that each of you download Zoom so we can do some more detailed conference calls with PowerPoint to familiarize each of you with the process.
- 5. Remote Voting Tools: The following programs were suggested for online voting: Google Forms, Survey Monkey, and Doodle Poll. Supreme listed the difficulty rating, as well as the cost and size of each program. Please check these out so you can guide your Assemblies for potential votes this June.
- 6. Online Meeting Practices: Once the Assembly gets set up with a program to hold their meetings, please ask them to do the following so the meetings will be productive and informative for all the members.
 - * Test the service in advance of the meeting.
 - * Make sure the host has strong Wifi .
 - * Ask all participants to MUTE their system or phone while the meeting is in progress. Un-mute when asked a question.
 - * Raise a hand for question in a chat box.
 - * Use emoji symbols thumbs up or thumbs down for voting.

The next webinar will give us all information on online Exemplifications, so make sure you and all your Assemblies sign up for that webinar. Supreme will send every member an Evite.

Supreme is working hard to allow us to use our God-given gifts and talents to serve God, our families, our Parish, and our communities. You must take advantage of this information and make it clear to your Assemblies that they must use the new tools that are becoming available to each of them through our Supreme Council. This is how we will serve. This is how our Assemblies will survive and activate all of its members to serve during these strange times where we suddenly find ourselves.

Star Assembly Award 2019-2020

Make sure your Assemblies plan to earn the Star Assembly Award for this fraternal year. As a reminder, here are the requirements for this Award.

- Publish and distribute to the Assembly membership a minimum of six Assembly Newsletters during the 2019-2020 fraternal year. A copy of each newsletter must also be sent (either in print or electronically) to the District Master, and Vice Supreme Master
- Meet the Assembly's membership goal with a net gain of 7% additions over deletions.
- Complete and submit the Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity (#1728), which is due January 31, 2020.
- Complete and submit to your District Master by April 30, 2020 the "To Be a Patriot Award" application.
- Earn the Civic Award by conducting a minimum of four patriotic programs during the 2019-2020 fraternal year and reporting those programs to the Supreme Master by June 30, 2020 on the "Civic Award" application.
- Complete and submit the "Report of Officers Chosen for the Term" (#186).
