October 2020 Prayer Rosary Rally

What and Why: The purpose of this program to unite our families in prayer and to grow in holiness. Our country is faced with many challenges during these times so we will unite in prayer and turn to God, our merciful Father, in whom we trust. Since there are five Saturdays in October 2020, the below intentions will be prayed for 1 per week. We encourage families to gather at 10AM each Saturday for this prayer. Through the decades of the rosary we pray 50 Hail Mary's – please remember these intentions affect us all in each of our beautiful 50 states. We ask our Mother Mary, all the heavenly angels and saints, and you my brothers and sisters to pray for the below intentions each week. May our Lord be with us and our Father answer the prayers.

Who and Where: The prayer can be said in person or virtually for everyone and anyone to participate. We will pray as a family and gather safely in groups, socially distancing and wearing masks, outside our churches, homes or inside churches if inclement weather. In Southaven, MS we will record and stream the prayer live so our council, church members, and families anywhere can pray with us virtually either "Live" or with the recording. The stream will occur via the Knights of Columbus State of Mississippi Facebook and Catholic Parishes of Northwest Mississippi Facebook. Councils across the State of MS are encouraged to record and broadcast live (if they have the capability) for their individual and/or mission parishes.

<u>What's next:</u> We are called to FAITH and ACTION so after you gather to pray consider an activity to put your faith into action (church grounds clean up, watch an Into the Breach video, food collection or distribution, or some other Leave No Neighbor Behind activity). Check with your Pastor to see what can be done to help his needs. Be creative and let's combine FAITH and ACTION!



Weekly Intentions:

October 3rd - Prayer for Life – pray for the unborn, for all life between conception and natural death and pray for our families. May we love everyone as we are all created in the image and likeness of God and pray for the end of abortion, euthanasia, addiction, suicide, and racism.

October 10th - Prayer for Health – pray for the physical and emotional health of all during the coronavirus pandemic; for thanksgiving and protection for the medical professionals, first responders, police, firefighters, educators and administrators that are serving during this time of the health crisis.

October 17th - Prayer for Peace – pray for unity, peace, and healing of our communities. For the end of civil unrest, violence and for our local and national leaders that they may lead us to love and serve one another. Pray for the conversion of those committing acts of violence in our cities and against our churches and religious institutions.

October 24th – Prayer for Unity – pray for marriage and married couples, for unity in our families, parishes, neighborhoods, and cities.

October 31st - Prayer for our religious and for vocations. On October 31st at a beatification Mass in Connecticut, Father Michael J. McGivney is to be beatified, the step just prior to sainthood, and he will be bestowed with the title "Blessed". As a parish priest and the founder of the Knights of Columbus we ask for his intercession in these prayers. We Pray for Pope Francis, our Bishops, Priests, Deacons, Sisters and all religious and for vocations for all.
