## A WORD FROM OUR STATE DEPUTY

Worthy State Officers, District Deputies, Grand Knights, and fellow Knights of the Mississippi Jurisdiction:

Did your council participate in the March membership BLITZ? If you didn't, you really missed out on a great opportunity. I am proud to report that <u>55</u> new members were recruited in March 07. That was a tremendous effort on everyone's part to make the BLITZ a success. For us to bring in 55 new members it took support from our Degree Teams, District Deputies, State Membership Director, and each and every Knight who asked an eligible Catholic man to join our Order. So you see, it is a team effort and my hat is off to each of you for your support.

Speaking about membership, I have one more bit of great news. As of today, we are at 78% of our Supreme membership goal which means we need only 62 more new members between now and 30 June 07. Here is an opportunity for every council to meet or exceed their membership goal set by Supreme which will qualify them for Star Council—if they have also done their paperwork and met their Insurance goal. We can do it—with everyone's support.

Is everyone prepared for next week's State Convention? I certainly hope so as we have a lot to celebrate and many councils and members to recognize for their achievements. Here are a few reminders concerning the convention:

- > The Beau Rivage is a busy place so check in early even if your room is not available yet. At least your paperwork is done.
- > There is a concert at the Beau on Friday night and parking will be at a premium. This is another reason to arrive early.
  - > There will be a District Deputy Meeting at 3 PM.
  - > There will be a Fourth Degree Meeting at 4 PM
  - > The first business meeting begins at 5:30 PM
- > Friday night's dinner will be at the Town Green, about 3 blocks from the hotel and activities begin at 7:30. Dress is casual since we will be outdoors.
  - > Convention registration opens at noon in the hotel.
  - > Convention agendas and Mass schedules will be available at registration.
  - > Hospitality rooms will be located at Council 1244's home on Water Street.
- > Any council that is not current in either their Supreme or State Per Capita will not be allowed representation at the convention (per Supreme and State By-Laws).

District Deputies, Program Directors and Chairmen, and Grand Knights are reminded to have their reports ready to hand in to the State Secretary at the first business meeting. There are lots of other things for you to consider: Car raffle ticket money should be turned in <a href="mailto:before">before</a> the convention. You should have your checks ready for the Priest Education Fund, the Mississippi Pro-Life Memorial Fund, and the Christopher Fund.

#### Dear Brother Knights and Ladies:

For more than fifty years the Knights of Columbus and members of the Ladies Auxiliary have supported our Bishop's with financial contributions to the Bishop R. O. Gerow Memorial Fund. During that time period your contributions have exceeded \$1,515,662.00 to help defray the cost of seminarian education. Last year your contributions exceeded \$90,441.00. Your contributions for the Jackson Diocese exceeded \$40,000.00 and you contributed \$53,172.00 for the Diocese of Biloxi.
