April is also a time when we celebrate the accomplishments of our councils across the state at our Annual State Convention the weekend of April 25-27, 2025. I want to invite and encourage all Knights to attend this year's convention in Jackson, MS. There is still time to register and join us at this fraternal gathering of Brother Knights and enjoy the fun events that the committee has scheduled.

I do want to remind everyone that although we will be celebrating our accomplishments this month the fraternal year does not end until June 30th, so there is still time for every council to Reach for the Stars and attain STAR Council status. A key aspect of the STAR Council requirements is the achievement of the council's membership quota for the fraternal year. To help encourage the councils to have a great end of the year, the State Council is offering a \$500 jackpot drawing, with the winning council to be drawn at the first School of Columbianism Meeting in July. Be watching for further details in the next week, but for every member signed up and brought into the council, one ticket with the council number will be entered into the drawing. One lucky council will receive \$500 to use as the council wishes.

I would also remind the councils that their submission of the SP-7 Columbian Award report is due no later than June 30th. This is a hard deadline that will not be extended. If councils have already attained the required programs to qualify for the Columbian Award, I encourage the council to submit their SP-7 now instead of waiting until June. If your council is still short a program or two, you still have time to get those scheduled in time to qualify.

There are other requirements to qualify for STAR, so each council should review their current position on the STAR Tracker with their District Deputy and set plans to close any gaps. Let's knock the lights out between now and July 1st and close out the fraternal year with an outstanding finish.




